Only dogs registered in FCI recognized stud books can take part at the dog show. Show will take place according to the CMKU show rules.

Program:

8:45 – 10:00 dog's acceptance
10:15 – 12:30 judging in the ring
from 12:45 final competitions, raffle

Final competitions:

Best couple: A bitch and a dog of the same breed exhibited at the show with the same owner or co-owners. The co-ownership must be stated in the pedigree.

Child and dog: Children above 5 years old, all dogs allowed.

We accept applications via dogoffice.cz

Depending on the situation, the organizers may prolong the deadline for the electronic applications.

Entry fees:

Minor puppy, puppy, honor and veteran	150 Kč/200 Kč	15 EUR (member 10 EUR)
1. dog	500 Kč/650 Kč	45 EUR (member 30 EUR)
2. dog and more	350 Kč/500 Kč	20 EUR (member 15 EUR)
Competitions	100 Kč/200 Kč	5 EUR (member 10 EUR)

Regardless of the number of dogs from minor puppy class, puppy, honor a veteran, you will be charged with the member/non-member price stated in the pricing chart above.

The application price increases after the closing date by 150 Kč (10 EUR) for each dog and a competition.

The show fee includes admission for one person/one dog. The fee should be paid by bank transfer. Please attach proof of payment to the application form. If you, for various reasons, cannot attend the exhibition, we do not provide any refunds of the entrance fees.

Classes:

- Division into classes according to the show regulations of the CMKU - it is stated in the application form.
- Honor class – (only for dogs with titles Champion or Interchampion, winners are not awarded by CAC nor compete for CACIB/BOB)
- To enter a dog in working class, the entry form must be accompanied by a copy of the FCI compulsory certificate.
- To enter a dog in Champion Class, one of the following titles must have been confirmed by the day of the official closing date of entries; proof of this, by copy, must be enclosed with the entry form.
- The age of the dog on the day of the show is decisive for him/her to be included in the class, the other conditions must be met on the day of application.
- A separate entry form must be filled out for each dog.
- **Each application must be accompanied by a double-sided photocopy of the dog's pedigree certificate and proof (copy) of payment of the show fee.**
- Reassignment of the dogs from one class to another (as a new request) is not allowed on the day of the exhibition.

Veterinary conditions:

1. All animals involved must be clinically healthy. (Even those do not compete)
2. Dogs originating from CR must be accompanied by valid vaccination certificate or by a valid small animal passport. Dogs originating from EU Member States and third countries must be accompanied by a valid small animal passport and must comply with the conditions laid down in Regulation 998/2003 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 26 May 2003.
3. Dogs that have not passed the veterinary examination within the specified time may not participate in the event.
4. Excluded from the show are bitches in heat, lactating and in the second half of pregnancy, aggressive dogs, and dogs with surgical procedures to remove defects in the exterior of the dog.

Dogs with cropped ears are not allowed into the show grounds and will not be judged.

Documents you need:

- entry form (it will be available no later than 7 days before the event)
- original pedigree or confirmation that pedigree will be issued (only for minor puppy or puppy class)
- vaccination card with valid vaccinations

General regulations:

The organizer is not responsible for damages caused by the dog or dog - the owner is responsible for all these damages. The exhibitor is responsible for the protection and well-being of the dog at the show. During the dog show, the owners will secure their animals so that there is no mutual attack or possible injury to persons. Free running of dogs is not allowed! Biting dogs must be muzzled. It is forbidden to modify the dog's coat, skin, or nose with anything that changes their structure, color or shape. It is forbidden to modify the dog in the exhibition grounds with the help of any substances or aids. Only cutting, trimming, combing and brushing are allowed. Violation of this provision may result in immediate expulsion from the dog show.

If the exhibition does not take place due to force majeure, the fees will be used to cover the costs of the dog show. Leading puppies for sale at the show is forbidden.

The exhibitor agrees with the publication of his address in the exhibition catalog. Photographs and videos can be taken at the dog show. By attending the event, the viewer agrees that he / she may be the subject of photographs and recordings. Exhibitors are obliged to comply with the provisions of the

FCI and CMKU Dog Show Rules, the instructions of the Dog Show Committee, to which they undertake by submitting an application.

Protest:

Protest against the judge's decision is not allowed. It is possible to protest only for formal reasons of violation of shown rules and propositions. The protest must be submitted in writing, together with the deposit of CZK 1,000, and only during the dog show. If the protest is not accepted, the principal will be forfeited in favor of the exhibition organizer.

Judge: Lothar Mende (DE) (judge may be subject to change)

Please note: the exhibition is governed by the current government regulation against the spread of covid-19, valid for the Czech Republic.

In case the exhibition cannot take place due to governmental anti-pandemic regulations, an alternative date will be proposed, or fees will be refunded to exhibitors who do not wish to exhibit on the alternative date.
