PAYMENT INSTRUCTIONS:

After completing the entry, the system will generate a reference number and the amount to be paid. Please include the reference number in your bank transfer.
After payment, return to the entry application and upload the proof of payment.

The entry will not be accepted without proof of payment! Entries not paid by the closing date will be cancelled without notice.

Important: Each entry form must be accompanied by a photocopy of both sides of the pedigree with the owner (co-owner) indicated, as well as photocopies of other required documents for entry in the working or champion class.

When entering through the application www.dogoffice.cz, you must receive a confirmation email. If this does not occur, the entry has not been completed! Applications sent by email will not be accepted!

Handling fees:

– Cancellation of an entry by the exhibitor before the last closing date – 50% of the entry fee.
After the final deadline, cancellation is no longer possible.

– Change of class at the request of the exhibitor before the last closing date – 15 EUR.

CLASSES:

The division into classes follows the Show Regulations of the CMKU and FCI and is indicated on the entry form. For the Working Class, an international working certificate must be submitted.

Entry into the Honour Class is conditional upon having obtained one of the following titles: National Winner, Club Winner, Specialty Winner, European Winner, World Winner, Champion of the Czech Republic, Champion of the CMKU, C.I.B., C.I.E., or a national champion title of any FCI member country. In the Honour Class, CAC is not awarded, and the dog awarded Excellent 1 does not proceed to the competition for CACIB and BOB or BOS.

Entry into the Champion Class (for non-FCI breeds this is the Winners Class) is conditional upon having obtained one of the following titles: Champion of the Czech Republic, Champion of the CMKU, C.I.B., C.I.E., or a national champion title of any FCI member country. A copy of the obtained title must be enclosed with the entry form. The listed titles must have been obtained in competition among adult dogs.

Varieties (colour, size, coat type) of some breeds are judged separately according to the FCI regulations. Titles cannot be claimed as a matter of right.

CERTIFICATES TOWARDS TITLES

CAJC, CAC ČR, CAC CMKU, Res. CAC ČR, CACIB, Res. CACIB, CACIB-J a CACIB-V

TITLES:

Best of Breed - BOB, Best of Opposite Sex - BOS, Best Junior in Breed - BOJ, Best Veteran of Breed - BOV, Junior Winner of FCI - JBIG, Junior Winner at the show - JBIS, winner of FCI group - BIG, winner of the show - BIS. Awarding of titles cannot be entitled. In the individual classes, first four dogs with grade very promising, promising and excellent or very good are placed.

Competitions:

- **Junior Handling** – age groups: I. 10–13 years, II. 13–18 years. The required age must be reached no later than the day before the show. The competition is held with a dog registered in an FCI-recognized studbook; the dog does not have to be judged at the show. The evaluation focuses on the handling of the dog, not on its quality. Points gained in Junior Handling at national and international shows can be included in the year-round national competition.
- **Best Puppy** – competition for the best dog or bitch awarded VP1 (Very Promising 1) in the Puppy Class.
- **Best Minor Puppy** – competition for the best dog or bitch awarded VP1 (Very Promising 1) in the Minor Puppy Class.
- **Best Veteran** – competition of the dogs awarded Best of Veteran (BOV).
- **Parade of Honour Class** – competition of dogs awarded Excellent 1 in the Honour Class.
- **Best Brace** – for one male and one female of the same breed and variety exhibited at the show, owned by the same owner or co-owners. Co-ownership must be documented in the pedigree.
- **Best Breeders Group** – for 3 to 5 dogs of the same breed and variety, exhibited at the show, bred by the same breeder, and coming from at least two different sires or dams.
- **Junior Winner of FCI Group (JBIG)** – competition of dogs awarded BOJ (Best of Junior) within each FCI Group.
- **Winner of FCI Group (BIG)** – competition of dogs awarded BOB (Best of Breed) within each FCI Group.
- **Junior Best in Show (JBIS)** – competition of the dogs awarded JBIG.
- **Best in Show (BIS)** – competition of the dogs awarded BIG.

FINAL COMPETITIONS – FOR FCI RECOGNIZED BREEDS ONLY.

NOTICE CHAMPIONS CERTIFICATE:

- Exhibitors whose dogs obtain the last required certificate for the title Czech Champion, Czech Junior Champion, Czech Grand Champion, Czech Veteran Champion or CMKU Champion at the DUO CACIB International Dog Show may present the necessary documents at the show office. Diplomas will be issued continuously between 10:30 and 15:00.

For issuing the diploma, the following documents are required:

- Original critiques as proof of obtaining the CAC,
- At least a copy of the pedigree,
- For breeds subject to working trials, also a copy of the working certificate.

Fee for issuing the championship diploma at the show:

- 30 EUR for foreign exhibitors.

Documents for participation in the exhibition:

- Pedigree
- EU Pet Passport
- Entry confirmation

Veterinary conditions:

All participating animals must be clinically healthy.

Dogs must be equipped with a Pet Passport or vaccination card containing a valid record of rabies vaccination.

Dogs coming from EU member states and third countries must be accompanied by a valid Pet Passport and must comply with the conditions laid down in Regulation (EC) No 998/2003 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 26 May 2003.

During the exhibition, owners must ensure their dogs are controlled in such a way as to prevent attacks on other animals or injury to people.

Instructions for completing entry forms:

The organizer does not accept responsibility for incorrectly completed entry forms. If a copy of the document proving that the dog meets the requirements for the Winners, Working or Champion Class is not attached to the entry, the dog will automatically be entered in the Open Class. Each dog may only be entered in one class. Re-classification of dogs after the last closing date is not possible.

Acceptance of the dog for the show will be confirmed approximately 10 days before the exhibition by an electronic entry pass available in the exhibitor's account in the Dogoffice.cz system. By submitting the entry, the exhibitor agrees to all provisions of the CMKU and FCI Show Regulations and the show propositions. The exhibitor agrees to the publication of their name and address in the show catalog.

General provisions:

The exhibition is open to all male and female dogs of breeds entered in studbooks recognized by the FCI, provided they have reached the age required for entry in the respective class on the day of the show.

The organizer is not responsible for any damage caused by the dog or exhibitor, nor for the death or loss of a dog during the show. Free running of dogs is not allowed on the show grounds. Dogs with cropped ears will not be admitted to the show and will not be judged.

The following are also excluded from the show: bitches in the second half of pregnancy, lactating bitches, and aggressive dogs.

It is forbidden to alter the coat, skin, or nose of the dog by any means that changes their structure, color, or shape. It is forbidden to treat or prepare a dog in the show area using any substances or devices. Only trimming, stripping, combing, and brushing are permitted. It is also forbidden to tie dogs up at the show. Violation of this rule may result in immediate exclusion from the Exhibition.

Owners of dogs awarded the BOB title are obliged to participate in the final competition of winners. Exhibitors are obliged to comply with the FCI and CMKU Show Regulations, these show propositions, and the instructions of the show committee, to which they commit themselves by submitting the entry form. Exhibitors acknowledge that they are obliged to maintain order on the show grounds.

In the event that the exhibition does not take place due to force majeure, the fees will be used to cover the expenses of the exhibition. Bringing puppies for the purpose of sale at the show is prohibited. The organizer reserves the right to change judges.

Protest:

A protest against the judge's decision is not admissible. Protests may be lodged only for formal reasons involving a violation of show regulations or propositions. The protest must be submitted in writing, accompanied by a deposit in the amount of twice the entry fee for one dog at the first closing date of the show, and only during the show. If the protest is not upheld, the deposit will be forfeited in favor of the organizer.
